1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the delivery of alcoholic beverages by the holder of a
 1-22 wine and beer retailer's permit.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 25, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
 1-25 by adding Section 25.15 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 25.15. DELIVERIES AND COLLECTIONS. The holder of a
 1-27 wine and beer retailer's permit who is also the holder of a local
 1-28 cartage permit may make deliveries to and collections from ultimate
 1-29 consumers in the same manner as the holder of a package store permit
 1-30 under Section 22.03.

1-31 SECTION 2. Section 43.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-32 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-33 (c) A package store, wine only package store, or wine and
 1-34 beer retailer's permittee who also holds a local cartage permit may
 1-35 make deliveries to and collections from customers in accordance
 1-36 with Section 22.03, 24.03, or 25.15, as appropriate.

1-37 SECTION 3. Section 43.04, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-38 amended to read as follows:

1-39 Sec. 43.04. ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMIT. The commission may
 1-40 issue a local cartage permit to a warehouse or transfer company or
 1-41 to a holder of a package store, wine only package store, wine and
 1-42 beer retailer's, or local distributor's permit.

1-43 SECTION 4. Section 74.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-44 amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

1-45 (h) This section does not authorize the holder of a brewpub
 1-46 license who also holds a wine and beer retailer's permit to deliver
 1-47 alcoholic beverages directly to ultimate consumers for off-premise
 1-48 consumption at a location other than the licensed premises.

1-49 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
