9	Sec. 114.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Commercial lodging establishment" means a hotel,
11	motel, inn, or similar entity that offers lodging to the public in

13	(2) "Military service member" means a member of:
14	(A) the armed forces of the United States;
15	(B) the Texas National Guard or the National
16	Guard of another state serving on active duty under an order of the
17	<pre>president of the United States;</pre>
18	(C) a reserve component of the armed forces of
19	the United States who is on active duty under an order of the
20	<pre>president of the United States; or</pre>
21	(D) the Texas military forces serving on state
22	active duty.
23	Sec. 114.002. MINIMUM AGE POLICY FOR LODGING WAIVED FOR
24	MILITARY SERVICE MEMBERS. A commercial lodging establishment that

- 1 imposes a minimum age policy that denies or restricts lodging to
- 2 individuals based on age shall waive that policy for a military
- 3 service member who:
- 4 (1) seeks to obtain lodging at the establishment; and
- 5 (2) presents a valid military identification card.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
