## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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2 relating to the eligibility of certain exhibitions and festivals to
3 receive funding through the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(4) and (5), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 6 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 7 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as 8 follows:

"Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate 9 (4) Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National 10 11 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National 12 Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl 13 14 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision 15 16 postseason playoff or championship game, the National Collegiate Athletic Association men's or women's lacrosse championships, a 17 World Cup Soccer game, the World Cup soccer tournament, the Major 18 League Soccer All-Star Game, the Major League Soccer Cup, the 19 20 Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association National Finals Rodeo, an 21 Elite Rodeo Association World Championship, the United States Open Championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship 22 23 of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an 24

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Olympic activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training 1 program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic 2 3 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games, a mixed martial arts 4 5 championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One automobile race, the Moto Grand Prix of the United States, the 6 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) All-Star 7 Race, the season-ending Championship Race for the National 8 Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), the Academy of 9 10 Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple Crown, <u>a world-renowned exhibition or festival that is recognized</u> 11 12 by the International World Exhibition & Festival Organization, a national political convention of the Republican National Committee 13 14 or the Democratic National Committee, a presidential general 15 election debate, or the largest event held each year at a sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating 16 17 capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less than 125,000. The term includes any activities related to or 18 associated with an event. 19

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(5) "Site selection organization" means:

21 (A) the National Football League, the National Athletic Association, the National 22 Collegiate Basketball Association, ESPN or an affiliate, the National Hockey League, 23 24 Major League Baseball, the Federation Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), the International World Games Association, the 25 26 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), Dorna Sports, the Amateur Athletic Union, the Professional Rodeo Cowboys 27

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1 Association, the Elite Rodeo Association, Major League Soccer, the United States Golf Association, or the United States Olympic 2 3 Committee; 4 the national governing body of a sport that (B) 5 is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, Formula One Management Limited, 6 7 or the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile; 8 (C) the Academy of Country Music; 9 (D) the National Cutting Horse Association; 10 (E) the International World Exhibition & Festival Organization; 11 12 (F) [<del>(E)</del>] the Republican National Committee or the Democratic National Committee; 13 14 (G) [(F)] the Ultimate Fighting Championship; or 15 (H) [<del>(G)</del>] the Commission on Presidential 16 Debates. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 21

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
