S.B. No. 1287

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of the Homeland Security Council.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 421.021(a), Government Code, as amended  
5 by Chapters 93 (S.B. 686), 616 (S.B. 1393), and 1217 (S.B. 1536),  
6 Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is reenacted  
7 and amended to read as follows:

8 (a) The Homeland Security Council is composed of the  
9 governor or the governor's designee, the speaker of the house of  
10 representatives or the speaker's designee, the lieutenant governor  
11 or the lieutenant governor's designee, and one representative of  
12 each of the following entities, appointed by the single statewide  
13 elected or appointed governing officer, administrative head, or  
14 chair, as appropriate, of the entity:

- 15 (1) Department of Agriculture;
- 16 (2) office of the attorney general;
- 17 (3) General Land Office;
- 18 (4) Public Utility Commission of Texas;
- 19 (5) Department of State Health Services;
- 20 (6) Department of Information Resources;
- 21 (7) Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas;
- 22 (8) Texas Division of Emergency Management;
- 23 (9) Texas Military Department;
- 24 (10) Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;

- 1 (11) Railroad Commission of Texas;
- 2 (12) Texas Military Preparedness Commission;
- 3 (13) Texas Department of Transportation;
- 4 (14) Commission on State Emergency Communications;
- 5 (15) Office of State-Federal Relations;
- 6 (16) secretary of state;
- 7 (17) Senate Committee on Veteran [~~Veterans~~] Affairs  
8 and Border Security [~~Military Installations~~];
- 9 (18) [~~(17)~~] the committee of the senate having  
10 jurisdiction over homeland security [~~Senate Committee on~~  
11 ~~Agriculture, Rural Affairs and Homeland Security~~];
- 12 (19) House Committee on Defense and Veterans' Affairs;
- 13 (20) [~~(18)~~] the committee of the house of  
14 representatives having jurisdiction over homeland security [~~House~~  
15 ~~Committee on Homeland Security and Public Safety~~];
- 16 (21) Texas Animal Health Commission;
- 17 (22) Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer  
18 Standards and Education;
- 19 (23) state fire marshal's office;
- 20 (24) Texas Education Agency;
- 21 (25) Texas Commission on Fire Protection;
- 22 (26) Parks and Wildlife Department;
- 23 (27) Texas A&M Forest Service; [~~and~~]
- 24 (28) Texas Water Development Board;
- 25 (29) Health and Human Services Commission;
- 26 (30) State Office of Risk Management;
- 27 (31) Texas School Safety Center; and

1           (32) Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

2           SECTION 2. Not later than the 90th day after the effective  
3 date of this Act, the governing officer, administrative head, or  
4 chair, as appropriate, of the Health and Human Services Commission,  
5 State Office of Risk Management, Texas School Safety Center, and  
6 Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall appoint a representative  
7 to the Homeland Security Council, as required by Section  
8 [421.021\(a\)](#), Government Code, as amended by this Act.

9           SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
