- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 151.355, Tax Code, is amended to read as 4
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 151.355. WATER-RELATED EXEMPTIONS. The following are
- 7 exempted from taxes imposed by this chapter:
- (1) equipment, services, or supplies used solely for 8
- 9 rainwater harvesting;
- (1-a) [equipment or supplies,] water recycling and 10
- reuse equipment or supplies $[\tau]$ or other equipment, services, or 11
- 12 supplies used solely to reduce or eliminate water use;
- 13 equipment, services, or supplies used solely for
- 14 desalination of surface water or groundwater;
- equipment, services, or supplies used solely for 15
- 16 brush control designed to enhance the availability of water;
- equipment, services, or supplies used solely for 17
- precipitation enhancement; 18
- equipment, services, or supplies used solely to 19
- construct or operate a water or wastewater system certified by the 20
- 21 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as a regional system;
- 22 equipment, services, or supplies used solely to
- 23 construct or operate a water supply or wastewater system by a

- 1 political subdivision that is a party to the project; and
- 2 (7) tangible personal property specifically used to
- 3 process, reuse, or recycle wastewater that will be used in
- 4 fracturing work performed at an oil or gas well.
- 5 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
- 6 tax liability accruing before the effective date of this Act. That
- 7 liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been enacted,
- 8 and the former law is continued in effect for the collection of
- 9 taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of the liability
- 10 for those taxes.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the first day of the
- 12 first month beginning on or after the earliest date on which this
- 13 Act may take effect if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the
- 14 members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article
- 15 III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote
- 16 necessary for effect before September 1, 2019, this Act takes
- 17 effect September 1, 2019.
