- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9681 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9681. FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION REQUIRED FOR DUAL
- 9 CREDIT STUDENTS. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 10 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 11 (b) Each student who earns a cumulative total of 15 or more
- 12 semester credit hours at an institution of higher education for
- 13 dual credit coursework successfully completed by the student before
- 14 the student's last semester or term in 12th grade must complete and
- 15 submit a free application for federal student aid (FAFSA) or, if
- 16 applicable, a Texas application for state financial aid (TASFA) not
- 17 later than the later of:
- 18 (1) six months after the last day of the semester or
- 19 term in which the student earns that cumulative total; or
- 20 (2) January 15 of the school year in which the student
- 21 <u>is enrolled in 12th grade.</u>
- (c) A student is not required to comply with Subsection (b)
- 23 if:
- 24 (1) the student's parent or other person standing in

- 1 parental relation submits a signed form indicating that the parent
- 2 or other person authorizes the student to decline to complete and
- 3 submit the financial aid application; or
- 4 (2) the student signs and submits the form described
- 5 by Subdivision (1) on the student's own behalf if the student is 18
- 6 years of age or older or the student's disabilities of minority have
- 7 been removed for general purposes under Chapter 31, Family Code.
- 8 (d) Each institution of higher education shall ensure that
- 9 each student to whom the institution awards the cumulative total of
- 10 semester credit hours described by Subsection (b) completes and
- 11 submits the financial aid application as required by that
- 12 <u>subsection</u> or <u>submits</u> a <u>signed</u> form to the institution under
- 13 Subsection (c).
- 14 (e) Each institution of higher education shall adopt a form
- 15 to be used for purposes of Subsection (c).
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 17 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
