## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the filing of a degree plan by students at public
- 3 institutions of higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.9685, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (c-2) and amending Subsection (g) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c-2) A student enrolled in a course for joint high school
- 9 and junior college credit under Section 130.008 at a public junior
- 10 college and to whom Subsection (b) or (c-1) does not apply shall
- 11 file a degree plan with the college not later than:
- 12 (1) the end of the second regular semester or term
- 13 <u>immediately following the semester or term in which the student</u>
- 14 <u>earned a cumulative total of 15 or more semester credit hours of</u>
- 15 course credit for dual credit courses successfully completed by the
- 16 student; or
- 17 (2) if the student begins the student's first semester
- 18 or term at the college with 15 or more semester credit hours of
- 19 course credit for dual credit courses successfully completed by the
- 20 student, the end of the student's second regular semester or term at
- 21 <u>the college.</u>
- 22 (g) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, in
- 23 consultation with institutions of higher education, shall [may]
- 24 adopt rules as necessary for the administration of this section,

- 1 including rules requiring institutions of higher education to
- 2 report to the board information regarding the filing of degree
- 3 plans as required by this section.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 130.0104(c), Education Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (c) In complying with the requirements regarding the filing
- 7 of a degree plan under [Notwithstanding] Section 51.9685, [before
- 8 the beginning of the regular semester or term immediately following
- 9 the semester or term in which] a student enrolled [successfully
- 10 completes a cumulative total of 30 or more semester credit hours for
- 11 coursework] in a multidisciplinary studies associate degree
- 12 program established under this section[, the student] must meet
- 13 with an academic advisor to complete a degree plan[, as defined by
- 14 Section 51.9685(a)(1)<sub>T</sub>] that:
- 15 (1) accounts for all remaining credit hours required
- 16 for the completion of the degree program; and
- 17 (2) emphasizes:
- 18 (A) the student's transition to a particular
- 19 four-year college or university that the student chooses; and
- 20 (B) preparations for the student's intended
- 21 field of study or major at the four-year college or university.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 23 academic year.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
