- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 264.015, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The commissioner of the department shall adopt rules
- 9 necessary to implement this section, including definitions of
- 10 "trauma" and "trauma-informed care," using a negotiated rulemaking
- 11 process under Chapter 2008, Government Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2019, the
- 13 commissioner of the Department of Family and Protective Services
- 14 shall adopt rules in accordance with Section 264.015(d), Family
- 15 Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
