## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the requirements for filing an annual financial

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 103.003(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The annual financial statement, including the auditor's
- 8 opinion on the statement, shall be filed in the office of the
- 9 municipal secretary or clerk:
- 10 (1) for a municipality with a population of less than
- 11 1.75 million, within 120  $[\frac{180}{1}]$  days after the last day of the
- 12 municipality's fiscal year; and
- 13 (2) for a municipality with a population of 1.75
- 14 million or more, within 90 days after the last day of the
- 15 municipality's fiscal year.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 17 103.003, Local Government Code, applies only to the filing of a
- 18 financial statement for a fiscal year ending on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
