4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.125 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 361.125. ROAD SPECIFICATIONS AND SAFETY STANDARDS FOR
8	ACCESS TO SOLID WASTE FACILITY. (a) The commission by rule shall:
9	(1) adopt specific, uniform road specifications and
10	safety standards for access to solid waste facilities that accept
11	or process municipal solid waste or hazardous waste; and
12	(2) require as a condition of a permit that the permit
13	holder comply with the rules adopted under Subdivision (1).
14	(b) Rules adopted under Subsection (a)(1) must:
15	(1) include standards or requirements for:
16	(A) safe railroad grade crossings;
17	(B) spill containment in high-risk areas;
18	(C) sufficient flood protection;
19	(D) vehicle weight and load limits that ensure
20	the access of commercial motor vehicles to the solid waste facility
21	without causing damage to the access routes;
22	(E) sight distance, as that term is defined by
23	Section 255.001, Transportation Code; and
24	(F) appropriate traffic control devices and

- 2 (2) require the permit holder to be financially
- 3 responsible for access route improvements and maintenance and to
- 4 reimburse a local governmental entity for any costs incurred by
- 5 that entity for improvements made to and maintenance of the access
- 6 routes; and
- 7 (3) require the permit holder to provide access to the
- 8 solid waste facility only through:
- 9 (A) a public highway;
- 10 (B) a dedicated county or municipal road;
- 11 (C) an easement for which the permit holder holds
- 12 a fee simple title; or
- 13 (D) an easement for which all owners of the
- 14 easement have agreed in writing to the use of the easement for
- 15 <u>ingress and egress to the facility.</u>
- 16 (c) The commission shall enforce this section, including
- 17 rules adopted under this section and conditions imposed under a
- 18 rule adopted under this section, and take an enforcement action
- 19 against a permit holder who violates this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall
- 22 adopt the rules required by Section 361.125, Health and Safety
- 23 Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
