A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to authorizing the sale of certain real property by the
- 3 Texas Facilities Commission on behalf of the state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) Subject to Subsections (b), (c), and (d) of
- 6 this section, the Texas Facilities Commission on behalf of the
- 7 state may convey the real property described by Section 2 of this
- 8 Act.
- 9 (b) The real property described by Section 2 of this Act may
- 10 not be conveyed by the Texas Facilities Commission on behalf of the
- 11 state for an amount less than the fair market value of the real
- 12 property. The fair market value of the real property must be
- 13 established by an independent appraisal obtained by the asset
- 14 management division of the General Land Office.
- 15 (c) The General Land Office shall negotiate and close a
- 16 transaction under this section on behalf of the Texas Facilities
- 17 Commission under Section 31.158, Natural Resources Code.
- 18 (d) The sale of the real property authorized by this section
- 19 must comply with 26 C.F.R. Sections 1.141-12(a), (b), (c), and (e).
- 20 This subsection prevails to the extent of any conflict between this
- 21 subsection and any provision of this Act or any other law.
- 22 SECTION 2. The real property is situated in Travis County,
- 23 Texas, and more particularly described as follows:
- (i) the tracts or parcels of land described in Austin,

- 1 Travis County, Texas, described in Exhibit I, attached hereto,
- 2 including all improvements on or under the land and all Grantor's
- 3 right, title and interest in and to adjacent streets, alleys and
- 4 rights-of-way, and adjacent strips and gores of real estate, and
- 5 all rights, titles, and interests appurtenant to the land and
- 6 improvements;
- 7 (ii) all licenses and rights, if any, whether surface,
- 8 subterranean, or aerial, pertinent to use of the land, improvements
- 9 or personalty, including, without limitation, the licenses
- 10 described in Exhibit II attached hereto and made a part hereof;
- 11 subject to zoning laws, regulations and ordinances of municipal and
- 12 other governmental authorities, if any, affecting the above
- 13 described Property and all the exceptions described in Exhibit III
- 14 attached hereto and made a part hereof, hereinafter called the
- 15 "Permitted Exceptions."

- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
