2-2 SECTION 4. Sections 547.105(a) and (b), Transportation 2-3 Code, are amended to read as follows:

2-4 (a) The Texas Department of Transportation shall adopt 2-5 standards and specifications that:

2-6 (1) apply to lamps on highway maintenance or 2-7 <u>construction vehicles</u> and service vehicles; and

2-8 (2) correlate with and conform as closely as possible 2-9 to standards and specifications approved by the American 2-10 Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials. 2-11 (b) The Texas Department of Transportation may adopt
