1 AN ACT
2 relating to the authority of a warehouse to store and ship wine.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 11.34(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) An applicant for a wholesaler's, class B wholesaler's,
- 7 distiller's and rectifier's, brewer's, or winery permit may
- 8 consolidate in a single application <u>an</u> [his] application for that
- 9 permit and an [his] application for:
- 10 (1) private storage;
- 11 (2) storage in a [public bonded] warehouse under
- 12 <u>Chapter 46</u>;
- 13 (3) a private carrier's permit; and
- 14 (4) any other permit the applicant [he] is qualified
- 15 to receive.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 45.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 45.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. The holder of a storage
- 19 permit may store liquor in a [public bonded] warehouse for which a
- 20 permit has been issued <u>under Chapter 46</u> or in a private warehouse
- 21 owned or leased by the holder and operated by the holder.
- SECTION 3. Sections 45.03(a) and (c), Alcoholic Beverage
- 23 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) A storage permit may be issued to a holder of a brewer's,

- 1 distiller's and rectifier's, winery, wholesaler's, class B
- 2 wholesaler's, [er] wine bottler's, or out-of-state winery direct
- 3 <u>shipper's</u> permit.
- 4 (c) Except as provided by this subsection, a storage permit
- 5 may not be issued for a location outside the county in which the
- 6 permittee's business is located. Subject to Section 45.04, the
- 7 holder of a winery permit or out-of-state winery direct shipper's
- 8 permit may obtain a storage permit for a location inside or outside
- 9 the county in which the permit holder's business is located.
- 10 SECTION 4. Chapter 46, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 CHAPTER 46. [BONDED] WAREHOUSE PERMIT
- Sec. 46.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. (a) The holder of a
- 14 [bonded] warehouse permit may:
- 15 <u>(1)</u> store liquor for any permittee who holds a permit
- 16 authorizing [its] storage of liquor in a [public bonded] warehouse
- 17 under this chapter; and
- 18 (2) deliver wine to ultimate consumers in fulfillment
- 19 of an order placed with the holder of a winery or out-of-state
- 20 winery direct shipper's permit whose wine is held in the warehouse.
- (b) Delivery of wine under Subsection (a) must be by the
- 22 holder of a carrier permit and comply with the provisions of Section
- 23 <u>16.09 or Chapter 54</u>, as applicable.
- Sec. 46.02. FEE. The annual state fee for a [bonded]
- 25 warehouse permit is \$150.
- Sec. 46.03. QUALIFICATIONS FOR PERMIT. (a) Except as
- 27 provided by Subsection (b), a [A bonded] warehouse permit may be

- 1 issued to any [public bonded] warehouse that [+
- 2 [(1) derives at least 50 percent of its gross revenue
- 3 in a bona fide manner during each three-month period from the
- 4 storage of goods or merchandise other than liquor; and
- 5 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ is not located in a dry area.
- 6 (b) A [bonded] warehouse permit may be issued to a [public
- 7 bonded] warehouse [described by Subsection (a)(1) of this section]
- 8 that is located in a dry area only for the storage of the wine of the
- 9 holder of a winery permit [who holds a permit authorizing its
- 10 storage in a public bonded warehouse].
- 11 Sec. 46.04. STORAGE INFORMATION. The holder of a [bonded]
- 12 warehouse permit shall furnish [such] information concerning the
- 13 liquor stored in and withdrawn from the warehouse as may be required
- 14 by the commission.
- 15 SECTION 5. Section 54.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 54.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. (a) The holder of an
- 18 out-of-state winery direct shipper's permit may sell and deliver
- 19 wine that is produced or bottled by the permittee to an ultimate
- 20 consumer located in the State of Texas. Delivery must be by the
- 21 holder of a carrier permit.
- 22 <u>(b) The holder of an out-of-state winery direct shipper's</u>
- 23 permit may store wine only in a warehouse for which a permit has
- 24 been issued under Chapter 46.
- 25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
