4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2166.5012 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2166.5012. ALAMO CENOTAPH. (a) In this section,
8	"Alamo Cenotaph" means the memorial to the Alamo defenders located
9	in the Alamo complex.
10	(b) Notwithstanding Subchapter I, Chapter 31, Natural
11	Resources Code, or any other law, the Alamo Cenotaph may not be
12	moved from the location where the cenotaph was first placed
13	following its completion unless:
14	(1) the commissioner of the General Land Office, the
15	Texas Historical Commission, and the Daughters of the Republic of
16	Texas approve the move; and
17	(2) the cenotaph is moved:
18	(A) temporarily for repairs; or
19	(B) permanently to a location within the Alamo
20	Plaza.
21	(c) The General Land Office has the power of eminent domain
22	to acquire in the manner provided by Chapter 21, Property Code, any
23	property necessary to preserve, maintain, and repair the Alamo
24	Cenotaph and to carry out the purposes of this section, including

- 1 the acquisition of the cenotaph and the land immediately underneath
- 2 and adjacent to the cenotaph.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
