5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 33.015(a), Human Resources Code, is

- amended to read as follows: 7 (a) In administering the supplemental nutrition assistance 8
- program, the commission shall, except as provided by Subsection (c) 9
- and Section 33.019, allow a person to comply with initial 10
- 11 eligibility requirements, including any initial interview, and
- 12 with subsequent periodic eligibility recertification requirements
- by telephone instead of through a personal appearance at commission 13
- 14 offices if:

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- 15 (1) the person and each member of the person's
- household: 16
- (A) have no earned income; and 17
- 18 are elderly or persons with disabilities; or
- the person is subject to a hardship, as determined 19 (2)
- 20 by commission rule.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
- 22 is amended by adding Section 33.019 to read as follows:
- 23 Sec. 33.019. SIMPLIFIED CERTIFICATION AND RECERTIFICATION
- REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN SNAP APPLICANTS AND RECIPIENTS. (a) The 24

- 1 commission shall develop and implement simplified certification
- 2 and recertification requirements for individuals who are 60 years
- 3 of age or older and who reside in a household in which every
- 4 individual residing in the household is 60 years of age or older.
- 5 The simplified requirements must:
- 6 (1) allow an individual described by this section to
- 7 waive initial certification and recertification interview
- 8 requirements;
- 9 (2) simplify and reduce the number of verification
- 10 requirements for certifying and recertifying eligibility to
- 11 receive benefits, which must include the use of a shortened
- 12 application form; and
- 13 (3) allow the individual to remain eligible for
- 14 benefits for 36 months after certification and after each
- 15 <u>recertification</u>.
- 16 (b) An individual described by this section is not required
- 17 to report to the commission during the 36-month eligibility period
- 18 unless the individual receives a significant increase in income or
- 19 assets during that period.
- 20 <u>(c)</u> The commission shall, in a manner that complies with
- 21 federal law, use data matching to help enroll in the supplemental
- 22 <u>nutrition assistance program eligible individuals described by</u>
- 23 this section who are receiving Medicaid or Medicare benefits.
- SECTION 3. Section 33.019, Human Resources Code, as added
- 25 by this Act, applies only to an application or recertification of
- 26 eligibility of a person for supplemental nutrition assistance
- 27 program benefits submitted on or after January 1, 2020.

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- 1 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 2 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 3 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 4 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 5 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 6 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
