## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT	

- 2 relating to the use of calculator applications in place of graphing
- 3 calculators in public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 25.904 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 25.904. USE OF CALCULATOR APPLICATION IN PLACE OF
- 8 GRAPHING CALCULATOR. (a) A school district shall permit a student
- 9 enrolled in a course that requires the student to use a graphing
- 10 calculator to use a calculator application on a computing device,
- 11 including a personal, laptop, or tablet computer, that provides the
- 12 same functionality, unless the district makes available to the
- 13 student a graphing calculator at no cost to the student.
- 14 (b) A school district may adopt policies related to student
- 15 use of a computing device under this section.
- 16 (c) To the extent this section conflicts with Section
- 17 <u>37.082</u>, this section prevails.
- 18 SECTION 2. The Texas Education Agency is required to
- 19 implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature
- 20 appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If the
- 21 legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 22 purpose, the Texas Education Agency may, but is not required to,
- 23 implement a provision of this Act using other appropriations
- 24 available for that purpose.

- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
