A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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2 relating to compliance with federal coding guidelines for certain 3 divisions and offices within the Health and Human Services 4 Commission.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 531.1023, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 531.1023. COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL CODING GUIDELINES. 9 <u>(a)</u> The commission's office of inspector general, including 10 office staff and any third party with which the office contracts to 11 perform coding services, <u>and the commission's medical and</u> 12 <u>utilization review appeals unit</u> shall comply with federal coding 13 guidelines, including guidelines for diagnosis-related group (DRG) 14 validation and related audits.

15 (b) In this section, "federal coding guidelines" means the 16 code sets and guidelines adopted by the United States Department of 17 Health and Human Services in accordance with the Health Insurance 18 Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (42 U.S.C. Section 1320d 19 et seq.).

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
