- 9 county that borders Arkansas and Louisiana may use revenue from the
- 10 municipal hotel occupancy tax for the promotion of tourism by the
- 11 enhancement and upgrading of an existing sports facility or field
- 12 as specified by Subsection (a)(7), provided that the requirements
- 13 of Subsection [Subsections] (a)(7)(A) [and (C)] and Section

- 15 SECTION 2. Section 351.1066(a), Tax Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 (a) This section applies only to:
- 18 (1) a municipality with a population of at least 3,500
- 19 but less than 5,500 that is the county seat of a county with a
- 20 population of less than 50,000 that borders a county with a
- 21 population of more than 1.6 million;
- 22 (2) a municipality with a population of at least 2,900
- 23 but less than 3,500 that is the county seat of a county with a
- 24 population of less than 22,000 that is bordered by the Trinity River

- 1 and includes a state park and a portion of a wildlife management
- 2 area;
- 3 (3) a municipality with a population of at least 7,500
- 4 that is located in a county that borders the Pecos River and that
- 5 has a population of not more than 15,000;
- 6 (4) a municipality with a population of not more than
- 7 5,000 that is located in a county through which the Frio River flows
- 8 and an interstate highway crosses, and that has a population of at
- 9 least 15,000; [and]
- 10 (5) a municipality with a population of not less than
- 11 7,500 that is located in a county with a population of not less than
- 12 40,000 but less than 250,000 that is adjacent to a county with a
- 13 population of less than 750; and
- 14 (6) a municipality that has a population of not more
- 15 than 25,000, that contains a cultural heritage museum, and that is
- 16 located in a county that borders the United Mexican States and the
- 17 Gulf of Mexico.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
