5	SECTION 1. Section 61.001, Labor Code, is amended by adding
6	Subdivision (6-a) to read as follows:
7	(6-a) "Payroll card account" means an account that is
8	directly or indirectly established by an employer into which each
9	participating employee's wages, salary, or other form of
10	compensation is deposited on a recurring basis and for which the
11	employee receives a payroll card to access the funds in the account.
12	SECTION 2. Section 61.016(a), Labor Code, is amended to
13	read as follows:
14	(a) An employer shall pay wages to an employee:
15	(1) in United States currency;
16	(2) by a written instrument issued by the employer
17	that is negotiable on demand at full face value for United States

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- 18 currency; or
- 19 (3) by the electronic transfer of funds to:
- 20 (A) a bank account designated by the employee; or
- 21 (B) a payroll card account established by the
- 22 employer.
- SECTION 3. Section 61.017, Labor Code, is amended by adding 23
- 24 Subsection (d) to read as follows:

- 1 (d) An employer may elect to pay wages to an employee
- 2 through a payroll card account plan that uses electronic funds
- 3 transfer to deposit wages in the employee's payroll card account.
- 4 An employer who desires to pay wages through a payroll card account
- 5 shall:
- 6 (1) notify each affected employee in writing that the
- 7 employer is adopting a payroll card account plan not later than:
- 8 (A) the 60th day before the date of the first
- 9 electronic funds transfer to the payroll card account; or
- 10 (B) the first day of work for an employee hired
- 11 after the date the employer adopts the plan;
- 12 (2) obtain from the employee any information required
- 13 by the payroll card account issuer that is necessary to implement
- 14 the electronic funds transfer;
- 15 (3) provide a complete list of all fees that may be
- 16 deducted from the employee's payroll card account by the employer
- 17 or payroll card account issuer in English, or, if the employer
- 18 offers a payroll card account to an employee in a language other
- 19 than English, in that other language; and
- 20 (4) provide a form the employee may use to request an
- 21 alternate form of payment if the employee elects to opt out of the
- 22 payroll card account plan.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
