4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 214.233(a), Local Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) A municipality [located in a county with a population of
8	two million or more] may adopt an ordinance requiring owners of
9	vacant buildings to register their buildings by filing a
10	registration form with a designated municipal official <u>if the</u>
11	<pre>municipality is located in:</pre>
12	(1) a county that has a population of two million or
13	more; or
14	(2) a county that:
15	(A) has a population of more than 285,000 and
16	less than 300,000; and
17	(B) borders the Gulf of Mexico.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
