- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 214.233, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) A municipality located in a county that has a
- 8 population of more than 285,000 and less than 300,000 and borders
- 9 the Gulf of Mexico may adopt an ordinance that allows but does not
- 10 require owners of vacant buildings to register their buildings by
- 11 filing a registration form with a designated municipal official. A
- 12 municipality that adopts an ordinance under this subsection may not
- 13 place a lien on a property solely because the property is registered
- 14 under this subsection.
- 15 (a-2) Subsection (a) may not be construed to grant a
- 16 municipality authority other than the authority to adopt an
- 17 ordinance described by that subsection.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
