5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 411.210 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 411.210. FIREARM SAFETY AND SUICIDE PREVENTION PUBLIC
8	AWARENESS CAMPAIGN. (a) The department shall develop and
9	implement a public awareness campaign designed to encourage firearm
10	safety and to improve public awareness on the topics of:
11	(1) prevention of firearm accidents involving
12	<u>children;</u>
13	(2) suicide prevention; and
14	(3) the safe handling and storage of firearms.
15	(b) In implementing the campaign, the department may engage
16	in online advocacy, issue public service announcements, and
17	distribute materials that cover the topics described by Subsection
18	(a). The department may publish its own materials or may distribute
19	materials published by firearm safety advocacy organizations.
20	(c) The department may establish a process under which an
21	applicant for an original or renewed license under this subchapter
22	may make a voluntary donation to support the campaign.
23	(d) The department may pay the costs of the campaign and its

1	(1) gifts, grants, or donations, including donations
2	collected under Subsection (c), if applicable;
3	(2) matching funds; and
4	(3) other funds made available for that purpose,
5	including available department revenue.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
