- 1 state-managed infrastructure programs on colonia residents;
- 2 (3) review public comments regarding the colonia needs
- 3 assessment incorporated into the state low income housing plan
- 4 under Section 2306.0721; and
- 5 (4) based on the public comments reviewed under
- 6 Subdivision (3), recommend to the board new colonia programs or
- 7 improvements to existing colonia programs.
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 6.060(d), 16.022, and 17.1245(b), Water
- 9 Code, are repealed.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
