4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 11.2011 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.2011. SUPERINTENDENT RESIGNATION OR TERMINATION OR
8	NONRENEWAL OF CONTRACT. (a) If the superintendent of a school
9	district leaves the employment of the district by resignation or by
10	the termination or nonrenewal of a contract, the school district
11	shall:
12	(1) post on the school district's Internet website, if
13	any:
14	(A) a notice of the resignation, termination, or
15	nonrenewal that includes any grounds for the resignation,
16	termination, or nonrenewal; and
17	(B) a copy of any agreement related to the
18	resignation, termination, or nonrenewal entered into between the
19	superintendent and the school district; and
20	(2) report the information required by Subdivision (1)
21	to the agency.
22	(b) The agency shall post the information sent to the agency
23	under Subsection (a)(2) on the agency's Internet website.
24	(c) A contract or agreement between a school district and a

- 2 (1) a confidentiality provision regarding the
- 3 resignation, termination, or nonrenewal or a resignation,
- 4 termination, or nonrenewal agreement or the grounds for
- 5 resignation, termination, or nonrenewal; or
- 6 (2) a provision prohibiting the district or agency
- 7 from posting the information required by Subsection (a)(1) on the

- 9 <u>(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules to implement this</u>
- 10 section.
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of
- 12 this section, this Act applies only to a resignation, termination,
- 13 or nonrenewal that occurs on or after the effective date of this
- 14 Act. A resignation, termination, or nonrenewal that occurred
- 15 before that date is governed by the law as it existed at the time the
- 16 resignation, termination, or nonrenewal occurred, and the former
- 17 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 18 (b) If a superintendent resigns or the superintendent's
- 19 contract is terminated or not renewed on or after the effective date
- 20 of this Act and the superintendent was, on the date of resignation,
- 21 termination, or nonrenewal, subject to an employment contract that
- 22 contains provisions that conflict with Section 11.2011, Education
- 23 Code, as added by this Act, the provisions of the employment
- 24 contract control to the extent of conflict during the term of that
- 25 contract.
- 26 (c) Section 11.2011(c), Education Code, as added by this
- 27 Act, applies only to an employment contract that is entered into or

- 1 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. An employment
- 2 contract entered into or renewed before that date is governed by the
- 3 law as it existed at the time the employment contract was entered
- 4 into or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 5 purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
