- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 231.009, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 231.009. PRECEDENCE OF <u>ELECTION</u> CONTEST [ON APPEAL].
- 8 An election contest has precedence in the <u>district and</u> appellate
- 9 courts and shall be disposed of as expeditiously as practicable.  $\underline{A}$
- 10 court must to the extent reasonably possible ensure that the action
- 11 is brought to final disposition before the expiration of the term of
- 12 the contested office.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an election contest filed on or after the effective date of this
- 15 Act. An election contest filed before the effective date of this Act
- 16 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 17 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 18 that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
