- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.004(e), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (e) Any course materials and instruction relating to human
- 8 sexuality, sexually transmitted diseases, or human
- 9 immunodeficiency virus or acquired immune deficiency syndrome
- 10 shall be selected by the board of trustees with the advice of the
- 11 local school health advisory council and must:
- 12 (1) present abstinence from sexual activity as the
- 13 preferred choice of behavior in relationship to all sexual activity
- 14 for unmarried persons of school age;
- 15 (2) devote more attention to abstinence from sexual
- 16 activity than to any other behavior;
- 17 (3) emphasize that abstinence from sexual activity, if
- 18 used consistently and correctly, is the only method that is 100
- 19 percent effective in preventing pregnancy, sexually transmitted
- 20 diseases, infection with human immunodeficiency virus or acquired
- 21 immune deficiency syndrome, and the emotional trauma associated
- 22 with adolescent sexual activity;
- 23 (4) direct adolescents to a standard of behavior in
- 24 which abstinence from sexual activity before marriage is the most

- 1 effective way to prevent pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases,
- 2 and infection with human immunodeficiency virus or acquired immune
- 3 deficiency syndrome; [and]
- 4 (5) teach contraception and condom use in terms of
- 5 human use reality rates instead of theoretical laboratory rates, if
- 6 instruction on contraception and condoms is included in curriculum
- 7 content; and
- 8 (6) be approved by the State Board of Education.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 10 school year.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
