(a) In this section, "compensation" means 10 salaries, wages, and employment stipends. 11 12 (b) Not later than the 30th day after the date the agency posts the information submitted by the district under the Public 13 14 Education Information Management System (PEIMS), a school district that maintains an Internet website shall post on the district's 15 16 website: (1) a listing of each district employee and the 17 employee's compensation for the school year; 18 (2) subject to Subsection (d), a copy of a contract 19 20 signed by: 21 (A) the district's superintendent; 22 (B) an athletic director; and 23 (C) each coach of any extracurricular athletic activity employed by the district; and 24

No. 1619 1 (3) a blank copy of each type of contract used by the 2 district under Section 21.002(a). 3 (c) If a school district does not maintain an Internet website, the district shall submit the information required by 4 Subsection (b) to the agency within the period provided by that 5 subsection. On receipt of the information submitted under this 6 7 subsection, the agency shall post the district's information on the 8 agency's Internet website. 9 (d) A copy of a contract described by Subsection (b)(2) that is posted on an Internet website under that subsection or 10 Subsection (c) must be redacted to exclude any information that is 11 12 confidential under Chapter 552, Government Code. (e) Information posted on an Internet website by a school 13 14 district or the agency as required by this section must be 15 maintained on that website until the applicable entity posts the information for the following school year. 16 17 (f) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to implement this section. 18 SECTION 2. Section 21.205, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 25 26 Sec. 21.205. TERM OF CONTRACT. Except as provided by Section 11.201(b), once 27 [Once] a teacher has completed the

probationary contract period, the term of a contract under this
subchapter may not exceed five school years.

3 SECTION 4. Section 21.206, Education Code, is amended by 4 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

5 (d) The board of trustees may not renew a teacher's term 6 contract earlier than the sixth month before the contract ends.

7 SECTION 5. Section 21.212, Education Code, is amended by 8 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

9 (g) The board of trustees may not renew a superintendent's 10 term contract earlier than the sixth month before the contract 11 ends.

SECTION 6. Section 11.201(b), Education Code, as amended by this Act, and Sections 21.206(d) and 21.212(g), Education Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a contract executed on or after the effective date of this Act. A contract executed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was executed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

19 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
