- 5 SECTION 1. Section 401.403(b), Occupations Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A person who holds a license [meets the requirements of
- 8 this chapter for licensing as an audiologist or audiologist intern
- 9 and who fits and dispenses hearing instruments must:
- 10 (1) [register with the department the person's
- 11 intention to fit and dispense hearing instruments;
- [$\frac{(2)}{(2)}$] comply with <u>rules adopted under this chapter</u>
- 13 related to fitting and dispensing hearing instruments [the
- 14 profession's code of ethics];
- 15 $\underline{(2)}$ [$\overline{(3)}$] comply with the federal Food and Drug
- 16 Administration guidelines for fitting and dispensing hearing
- 17 instruments;
- 18 $\underline{(3)}$ [$\underline{(4)}$] when providing services in this state, use a
- 19 written contract that contains the department's name, mailing
- 20 address, [and] telephone number, and Internet website address; and
- (4) $[\frac{(5)}{(5)}]$ follow the guidelines adopted by commission
- 22 rule for a 30-day trial period on every hearing instrument
- 23 purchased.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
