13	(b) A municipality and a county may not adopt or enforce an
14	ordinance, order, or other measure that requires a person to enter
15	into a labor peace agreement with the employees of the person or to
16	waive or limit any right of the person under federal labor law as a
17	<pre>condition of:</pre>
18	(1) being considered for or awarded a contract; or
19	(2) otherwise engaging in a commercial transaction
20	with the municipality or county.
