- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 67.007(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) The county election returns shall state, for each 7 candidate and for and against each measure:
- 8 $(1)[\tau]$ the total number of votes received in the county
- 9 as stated by the local canvassing authority's tabulation of votes;
- 10 (2) the total number of early voting votes cast by
- 11 personal appearance received in the county; and
- 12 (3) the total number of early voting votes cast by mail
- 13 received in the county.
- SECTION 2. Section 68.004(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (b) The periodic reports may include:
- 17 (1) vote totals for all contested races being
- 18 tabulated;
- 19 (2) vote totals by county for federal offices and
- 20 statewide offices of the state government;
- 21 (3) vote totals for federal offices and statewide
- 22 offices of the state government in each of the six most populous
- 23 counties, the total for the next 19 most populous counties, and the
- 24 total for the remaining 229 counties; [and]

- 1 (4) the total number of early voting votes cast by
- 2 personal appearance and the total number of early voting votes cast
- 3 by mail for all contested races being tabulated; and
- 4 <u>(5)</u> any other information the secretary of state
- 5 determines to be relevant.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 87.027, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (i-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(i-1)</u> The signature verification committee may compare the
- 9 signature on each carrier envelope certificate, except those signed
- 10 for a voter by a witness, with the signatures on other carrier
- 11 envelope certificates received for the same election to determine
- 12 whether the same voter cast more than one ballot by mail. A
- 13 determination under this subsection that the same voter cast more
- 14 than one ballot by mail must be made by a majority vote of the
- 15 <u>committee's membership. The committee must report a determination</u>
- 16 <u>under this subsection that the same voter cast more than one ballot</u>
- 17 by mail in the same election to the attorney general and the
- 18 attorney general shall investigate the allegations. The secretary
- 19 of state may adopt rules relating to the information included in a
- 20 report to the attorney general under this subsection.
- SECTION 4. Section 87.042(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (b) The [Except as provided by Subsection (c), the] board
- 24 shall place the ballot envelope containing an accepted ballot in \underline{a}
- 25 separate ballot box from the ballot box containing the early voting
- 26 ballots voted by personal appearance.
- 27 SECTION 5. Section 87.103, Election Code, is amended by

- 3 (b) The early voting returns prepared at the central
- 4 counting station must include any early voting results obtained by
- 5 the early voting ballot board under Subchapter [Subchapters] D [and
- $6 \quad \mathbf{E}$].
- 7 (c) The early voting votes cast by personal appearance shall
- 8 <u>be tabulated separately from the early voting votes cast by mail and</u>
- 9 shall be separately reported on the returns.
- 10 SECTION 6. Section 87.124, Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 87.124. PRESERVATION OF EARLY VOTING ELECTION RECORDS
- 13 GENERALLY. The early voting election returns, voted early voting
- 14 ballots, and other early voting election records shall be preserved
- 15 after the election in the same manner as the corresponding precinct
- 16 election records <u>except that early voting ballots voted by mail</u>
- 17 shall be preserved in a separate container from early voting
- 18 ballots cast by personal appearance.
- 19 SECTION 7. Section 87.042(c), Election Code, is repealed.
- 20 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
