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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the administration of and benefits payable under the 3 Texas public school retired employees group insurance program and 4 the Texas school employees uniform group health coverage program 5 and certain expenditures for school employee health coverage.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 825.114(b), Government Code, is amended 8 to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the board 9 (b) of trustees by rule shall determine the amount and manner of any 10 11 compensation or expense reimbursement to be paid members of an 12 advisory committee performing service for the retirement system for performing the work of the advisory committee. All compensation 13 14 and expense reimbursements for an advisory committee established under this section are payable from the expense account or the Texas 15 16 public [retired] school retired employees group health benefits trust [insurance] fund, as applicable. 17

18 SECTION 2. Section 1456.004(c), Insurance Code, is amended 19 to read as follows:

Sections 1575.002(3) and (4), Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows: 16 17 (3) "Fund" means the Texas public [retired] school retired employees group health benefits trust [insurance] fund. 18 (4) "Group program" means the Texas Public School 19 <u>Retired</u> Employees Group <u>Health Benefits</u> [<u>Insurance</u>] Program 20 authorized by this chapter. 21 SECTION 6. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 1575, 22 Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows: 23 SUBCHAPTER G. TEXAS PUBLIC SCHOOL RETIRED [SCHOOL] EMPLOYEES GROUP 24 25 HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST [INSURANCE] FUND 26 SECTION 7. Section 1575.301(a), Insurance Code, is amended 27 to read as follows:

Sections 1579.002(5) and (6), Insurance Code, 5 are amended to read as follows: 6 (5) "Participating entity" means an entity 7 participating in the uniform group health coverage program 8 established under this chapter. The term includes: a school district; 9 (A) 10 (B) another educational district whose employees are members of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas; 11 a regional education service center; and 12 (C) a charter school that meets the requirements 13 (D) 14 of Section 1579.154. 15 (6) "Program" means the <u>Texas school employees</u> uniform group health coverage program established under this chapter. 16 17 SECTION 9. Section 1579.006(a), Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows: 18 The following are exempt from execution, attachment, 19 (a) garnishment, or any other process: 20 21 (1) benefit payments, including optional benefit 22 payments; (2) contributions of [active] employees, the state, 23 24 and a participating entity, and any other contributions; 25 (3) any rights, benefits, or payments accruing to any 26 person under this chapter; and any money in the Texas school employees uniform 27 (4)

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1 group <u>health</u> coverage trust fund.

2 SECTION 10. Section 1579.051, Insurance Code, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 Sec. 1579.051. ADMINISTRATION OF GROUP PROGRAM. The 5 Teacher Retirement System of Texas, as trustee, shall implement and 6 administer the uniform group <u>health</u> coverage program described by 7 this chapter.

8 SECTION 11. Section 1579.254, Insurance Code, is amended to 9 read as follows:

10 Sec. 1579.254. CONTRIBUTIONS HELD IN TRUST FOR FUND. A 11 participating entity:

(1) shall hold contributions required by this
 subchapter in trust for the Texas school employees uniform group
 <u>health</u> coverage trust fund and its participants; and

15 (2) may not divert the contributions for any other16 purpose.

SECTION 12. Section 1579.255(a), Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A participating entity that does not remit to the
trustee all contributions required by this subchapter before the
seventh day after the last day of the month shall pay to the Texas
school employees uniform group <u>health</u> coverage trust fund:

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(1) the contributions; and

(2) interest on the unpaid amounts at the annual rateof six percent compounded monthly.

26 SECTION 13. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 1579, 27 Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

The heading to Subchapter B, Chapter 1581, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows: 9 SUBCHAPTER B. MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT; MINIMUM EFFORT; REPORT 10 SECTION 16. Section 1581.052(b), Insurance Code, is amended 11 to read as follows: 12 Amounts used as required by this section shall be 13 (b) 14 deposited, as applicable, in: 15 (1) the Texas school employees uniform group health 16 coverage trust fund established under Subchapter G, Chapter 1579; 17 or (2) another fund established for the payment 18 of 19 employee health coverage that meets requirements for those funds prescribed by the Texas Education Agency. 20 21 SECTION 17. Subchapter B, Chapter 1581, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Section 1581.055 to read as follows: 22 Sec. 1581.055. ANNUAL REPORT. Each school district, other 23 24 educational district whose employees are members of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, participating charter school, and 25 26 regional education service center shall annually report to the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, according to rules adopted by 27

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the board of trustees of the retirement system, the monthly amount 1 the school district, other educational district, participating 2 charter school, or regional education service center contributes 3 4 under this chapter. SECTION 18. Section 1579.106(c), Insurance Code, 5 is 6 repealed. SECTION 19. Section 1456.004(c), Insurance Code, as amended 7 8 by this Act, applies only to charges for a health care service or supply provided on or after the effective date of this Act. Charges 9 for a health care service or supply provided before the effective 10

11 date of this Act are governed by the law as it existed immediately 12 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 13 effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 20. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
