- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 822.003(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person terminates membership in the retirement system
- 8 by:
- 9 (1) death;
- 10 (2) retirement;
- 11 (3) withdrawal of all of the person's accumulated
- 12 contributions while the person is absent from service; or
- 13 (4) not qualifying for service credit for five
- 14 consecutive years.
- SECTION 2. Section 822.005(d), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (d) The retirement system shall adopt procedures to track
- 18 and compile information of all applications filed under this
- 19 section from the time an application is made until [any warrant for]
- 20 the refund is issued by the retirement system.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 823.006, Government Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 823.006. LIMITS ON ANNUAL CONTRIBUTIONS FOR PURCHASE
- 24 OF SERVICE CREDIT. Notwithstanding any other provision of this

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- 1 subtitle, the retirement system shall [may] limit the purchase of
- 2 service credit to the extent required by applicable limits on the
- 3 amount of annual contributions a participant may make to a
- 4 qualified plan under Sections 401(a) and 415(c), Internal Revenue
- 5 Code of 1986.
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 824.101(g), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (g) Receipt by the retirement system of a certified copy of
- 9 a divorce or annulment decree between a member or annuitant and a
- 10 designated beneficiary revokes any designation of the former spouse
- 11 as beneficiary of any death benefits payable under Subchapter E or F
- 12 of this chapter that was effective before the date of divorce or
- 13 <u>annulment</u>, if the decree is received by the retirement system
- 14 before the payment of any part of the death benefit to any
- 15 beneficiary.
- SECTION 5. Section 824.1013(c-1), Government Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a trust designated as
- 19 a beneficiary under this section is entitled on the retiree's death
- 20 to receive monthly payments of the survivor's portion of the
- 21 retiree's optional retirement annuity for the remainder of the
- 22 trust beneficiary's life if the beneficiary designated at the time
- 23 of the retiree's retirement is the sole beneficiary of the trust. A
- 24 beneficiary designated under this section is entitled on the
- 25 retiree's death to receive monthly payments of the survivor's
- 26 portion of the retiree's optional retirement annuity for the
- 27 remainder of the beneficiary's life if the beneficiary designated

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- 1 at the time of the retiree's retirement is a trust and the
- 2 beneficiary designated under this section is:
- 3 (1) the sole beneficiary of that trust; or
- 4 (2) an individual who at the time of the retiree's
- 5 death is the sole beneficiary of that trust.
- 6 SECTION 6. Section 824.201(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A member may apply for a service retirement annuity by
- 9 filing an [a written] application for retirement with the board of
- 10 trustees.
- SECTION 7. Section 824.301(a), Government Code, is amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 (a) A member may apply for a disability retirement annuity
- 14 by:
- 15 (1) filing <u>an</u> [a written] application for retirement
- 16 with the board of trustees; or
- 17 (2) having an application filed with the board by the
- 18 member's legal representative.
- 19 SECTION 8. The heading to Section 824.404, Government Code,
- 20 is amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 824.404. OPTIONAL MONTHLY SURVIVOR BENEFITS.
- 22 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
