Article 43.13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c), (d), 5 6 and (e) to read as follows: (b) A defendant convicted of a misdemeanor and sentenced to 7 a term of confinement [of more than 30 days] discharges the 8 defendant's sentence at any time beginning at [between the hours 9 of] 6 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. [7 p.m.] on the day of discharge. 10 (c) Except as provided by Subsections (d) and (e), the 11 sheriff or other county jail administrator shall release a 12 defendant at any time beginning at 6 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. on the 13 day the defendant discharges the defendant's sentence. 14 15 (d) The sheriff or other county jail administrator may: (1) credit a defendant with not more than 18 hours of 16 17 time served; and (2) release the defendant at any time beginning at 6 18 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. on the day preceding the day on which the 19 defendant discharges the defendant's sentence. 20 21 (e) A sheriff or other county jail administrator may release a defendant from county jail after 5 p.m. and before 6 a.m. if the 22
