4	SECTION 1. Article 43.13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
5	amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c), (d),
6	and (e) to read as follows:
7	(b) A defendant convicted of a misdemeanor and sentenced to
8	a term of confinement [ <del>of more than 30 days</del> ] discharges the
9	defendant's sentence at any time <u>beginning at</u> [between the hours
10	$\frac{\text{of}}{\text{of}}$ 6 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. [7 p.m.] on the day of discharge.
11	(c) Except as provided by Subsections (d) and (e), the
12	sheriff or other county jail administrator shall release a
13	defendant at any time beginning at 6 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. on the
14	day the defendant discharges the defendant's sentence.
15	(d) The sheriff or other county jail administrator may:
16	(1) credit a defendant with not more than 18 hours of
17	time served; and
18	(2) release the defendant at any time beginning at 6
19	a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. on the day preceding the day on which the
20	defendant discharges the defendant's sentence.
21	(e) A sheriff or other county jail administrator may release

a defendant from county jail after 5 p.m. and before 6 a.m. if the

(1) agrees to or requests a release after 5 p.m. and
