5	SECTION 1. Section 261.101, Human Resources Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
7	(f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
8	the powers of the office include:
9	(1) the inspection of:
10	(A) a facility operated by the department under
11	Subtitle C;
12	(B) a post-adjudication secure correctional
13	facility under Section 51.125, Family Code;
14	(C) a nonsecure correctional facility under
15	Section 51.126, Family Code; and
16	(D) any other residential facility in which a
17	child adjudicated as having engaged in conduct indicating a need
18	for supervision or delinquent conduct is placed by court order; and
19	(2) the investigation of complaints alleging a
20	violation of the rights of the children committed to or placed in a
21	facility described by this subsection.
22	SECTION 2. The following provisions of the Human Resources
23	Code are repealed:
