## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a pilot program to provide additional funding to a
3	school district to improve the performance of certain campuses
4	under the accountability system.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 39A, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 39A.907 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 39A.907. PILOT PROGRAM FOR ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR
9	CAMPUS IMPROVEMENT. (a) The commissioner shall establish a campus
10	improvement pilot program in which a participating school district
11	with a campus that is assigned an overall performance rating of
12	needs improvement or unacceptable performance under Subchapter C,
13	Chapter 39, will receive additional state aid to implement a campus
14	improvement plan.
15	(b) The commissioner shall select not more than 12 school
16	districts in each state fiscal biennium to participate in the pilot
17	program. A district is eligible to apply to the commissioner to
18	participate in the program if:
19	(1) the district has a campus that is assigned an
20	overall performance rating under Subchapter C, Chapter 39, of needs
21	improvement or unacceptable performance;

(2) the district is located in a municipality or a

- 1 <u>determined by the commissioner; and</u>
- 2 (3) an open-enrollment charter school operating for
- 3 the first year is located in the boundaries of the district.
- 4 (c) A school district that meets the eligibility criteria
- 5 established under Subsection (b) and commissioner rules adopted
- 6 under this section may apply to the commissioner for selection to
- 7 participate in the pilot program. To be selected, the district must
- 8 submit a campus improvement plan as described by Section 11.253
- 9 that identifies performance goals to be implemented to improve the
- 10 performance of the campus.
- 11 (d) Subchapter B does not apply to the campus of the school
- 12 district selected for participation in the pilot program and a
- 13 campus intervention team may not be assigned under Section 39A.051
- 14 for the state fiscal biennium during which the district
- 15 participates in the program established under this section.
- 16 (e) A district participating in the pilot program is
- 17 entitled to additional state aid to implement the campus
- 18 improvement plan described by Subsection (c). For each student of
- 19 the campus in average daily attendance the district will receive
- 20 additional funding in an amount equal to what the campus would
- 21 receive under Section 12.106 if the campus was an open-enrollment
- 22 charter school. A school district may use additional state aid only
- 23 for the purpose of implementing the campus improvement plan.
- 24 (f) Not later than August 31 of the second school year of the
- 25 state fiscal biennium during which a school district participates
- 26 in the pilot program, the board of trustees of the district shall
- 27 issue a report to the commissioner regarding the implementation of

- 1 the campus improvement plan. The report must provide the most
- 2 recent performance rating of the campus and indicate whether the
- 3 campus improved under the plan. A school district's participation
- 4 in the program ends on August 31 of the second school year of the
- 5 state fiscal biennium.
- 6 (g) If the performance of a campus that is the subject of a
- 7 campus improvement plan described by Subsection (c) is assigned an
- 8 overall performance rating under Subchapter C, Chapter 39, for the
- 9 second school year of the state fiscal biennium during which the
- 10 school district participates in the pilot program that is two or
- 11 more performance ratings higher than the performance rating
- 12 assigned the campus for the school year preceding the district's
- 13 participation in the program, the district is entitled to the
- 14 additional state aid described by Subsection (e) for each school
- 15 year of the state fiscal biennium occurring after the district's
- 16 participation in the program ends under Subsection (f).
- 17 (h) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 18 implement this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
