S.B. No. 1714

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the requirement that an applicant for a reciprocal  
3 license, certificate, or permit to practice barbering or  
4 cosmetology pass an examination; authorizing a fee.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 1603.204(b), Occupations Code, is  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 (b) The person must:

9 (1) submit an application for the license,  
10 certificate, or permit to the department; ~~and~~

11 (2) pay fees in an amount prescribed by the  
12 commission, including any applicable license, certificate, ~~or~~  
13 permit, or examination fee; and

14 (3) pass the applicable examination required for  
15 issuance of the license, certificate, or permit.

16 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2019, the Texas  
17 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules necessary  
18 to implement the changes in law made by this Act.

19 (b) Section 1603.204(b), Occupations Code, as amended by  
20 this Act, applies only to an application for the issuance of a  
21 license, certificate, or permit submitted to the Texas Department  
22 of Licensing and Regulation on or after the effective date of this  
23 Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act  
24 is governed by the law in effect on the date the application was

1 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that  
2 purpose.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
