- 11 (2) pay fees in an amount prescribed by the
- 12 commission, including any applicable license, certificate, [ex]

- 14 (3) pass the applicable examination required for
- 15 issuance of the license, certificate, or permit.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2019, the Texas
- 17 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules necessary
- 18 to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- 19 (b) Section 1603.204(b), Occupations Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act, applies only to an application for the issuance of a
- 21 license, certificate, or permit submitted to the Texas Department
- 22 of Licensing and Regulation on or after the effective date of this
- 23 Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act
- 24 is governed by the law in effect on the date the application was

- 1 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
