## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

		AN ACT
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- 2 relating to a study by the Texas Water Development Board of
- 3 groundwater conditions in certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. In order to engage in a scientific inquiry and
- 6 analysis regarding current and projected groundwater production
- 7 and to assess the effects of that production on groundwater
- 8 conditions, the executive administrator of the Texas Water
- 9 Development Board shall, for the Trinity and Edwards Aquifers in
- 10 Bell, Burnet, Milam, Travis, and Williamson Counties:
- 11 (1) compile and evaluate current data on groundwater
- 12 levels, aguifer characteristics, and groundwater use and
- 13 production; and
- 14 (2) fully assess the effects of current and projected
- 15 groundwater production on groundwater conditions.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2020, the executive
- 17 administrator of the Texas Water Development Board shall:
- 18 (1) complete the compilation and evaluation of data
- 19 and prepare a report responsive to the technical scope described by
- 20 Section 1 of this Act; and
- 21 (2) make copies of the report available to the public.
- 22 SECTION 3. The executive administrator of the Texas Water
- 23 Development Board is required to implement this Act only if the
- 24 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose.

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- 1 SECTION 4. This Act expires September 1, 2021.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
