 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the dissolution of a non-profit direct-support  
 1-20 organization.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 54.633, Education Code, is amended by  
 1-23 adding Subsection (n) to read as follows:

1-24 (n) If the comptroller determines that the purpose of a  
 1-25 direct-support organization established under Subsection (e) has  
 1-26 been substantially complied with, the comptroller may dissolve the  
 1-27 organization. On dissolution, the title to all funds and  
 1-28 properties then owned by the organization shall transfer to the  
 1-29 Texas Match the Promise Foundation.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
