S.B. No. 1742

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to physician and health care provider directories for
3	certain health benefit plans.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1451.501, Insurance Code, is amended by
6	amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (1-b) to
7	read as follows:
8	(1) <u>"Facility" has the meaning assigned by Section</u>
9	324.001, Health and Safety Code.
10	(1-a) "Facility-based physician" means a radiologist,
11	anesthesiologist, pathologist, emergency department physician,
12	neonatologist, or assistant surgeon:
13	(A) to whom a facility has granted clinical
14	privileges; and
15	(B) who provides services to patients of the
16	facility under those clinical privileges.
17	<u>(1-b)</u> "Health care provider" means a practitioner,
18	institutional provider, or other person or organization that
19	furnishes health care services and that is licensed or otherwise
20	authorized to practice in this state. The term includes a
21	pharmacist, pharmacy, hospital, nursing home, or other medical or
22	health-related service facility that provides care for the sick or
23	injured or other care. The term does not include a physician.
24	SECTION 2. Section 1451.504, Insurance Code, is amended by

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1 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read 2 as follows:

3 (b) The directory must include the name, street address, 4 <u>specialty, if any,</u> and telephone number of each physician and 5 health care provider described by Subsection (a) and indicate 6 whether the physician or provider is accepting new patients.

7 (c) For each health care provider that is a facility
8 included in the directory under this section, the directory must:

9 (1) list under the facility name separate headings for 10 radiologists, anesthesiologists, pathologists, emergency 11 department physicians, neonatologists, and assistant surgeons;

12 (2) list under each heading described by Subdivision
13 (1) each facility-based physician described by Subsection (a)
14 practicing in the specialty corresponding with that heading that is
15 a preferred provider, exclusive provider, or network physician;

16 (3) for the facility and each facility-based physician 17 described by Subdivision (2), clearly indicate each health benefit 18 plan issued by the issuer that may provide coverage for the services 19 provided by that facility or physician; and

20 (4) include the facility in a listing of all 21 facilities included in the directory indicating:

22 (A) the name of the facility;
23 (B) the municipality in which the facility is
24 located or county in which the facility is located if the facility
25 is in the unincorporated area of the county;

26 (C) for each specialty of facility-based
27 physician practicing at the facility, the name, street address, and

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1	telephone number of any facility-based physician that is a
2	preferred provider, exclusive provider, or network physician or of
3	the physician group in which the facility-based physician
4	practices;
5	(D) each health benefit plan issued by the issuer
6	that may provide coverage for the services provided by the
7	facility; and
8	(E) each health benefit plan issued by the issuer
9	that may provide coverage for the services provided by each
10	facility-based physician group.
11	(d) The directory must list a facility-based physician
12	individually and, if the physician belongs to a physician group, as
13	part of the physician group.
14	SECTION 3. Section 1451.505(c), Insurance Code, is amended
15	to read as follows:
16	(c) The directory must be:
17	(1) electronically searchable by physician or health
18	care provider name, specialty, if any, facility, and location; and
19	(2) publicly accessible without necessity of
20	providing a password, a user name, or personally identifiable
21	information.
22	SECTION 4. A health benefit plan issuer shall update the
23	issuer's website to conform with Subchapter K, Chapter 1451,
24	Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, not later than January 1,
25	2020.
26	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
