A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to physician and health care provider directories for
- 3 certain health benefit plans.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1451.501, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (1-b) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (1) "Facility" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 9 324.001, Health and Safety Code.
- 10 (1-a) "Facility-based physician" means a radiologist,
- 11 anesthesiologist, pathologist, emergency department physician,
- 12 neonatologist, or assistant surgeon:
- 13 (A) to whom a facility has granted clinical
- 14 privileges; and
- 15 (B) who provides services to patients of the
- 16 <u>facility under those clinical privileges.</u>
- 17 <u>(1-b)</u> "Health care provider" means a practitioner,
- 18 institutional provider, or other person or organization that
- 19 furnishes health care services and that is licensed or otherwise
- 20 authorized to practice in this state. The term includes a
- 21 pharmacist, pharmacy, hospital, nursing home, or other medical or
- 22 health-related service facility that provides care for the sick or
- 23 injured or other care. The term does not include a physician.
- SECTION 2. Section 1451.504, Insurance Code, is amended by

- 1 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 2 follows:
- 3 (b) The directory must include the name, street address,
- 4 specialty, if any, and telephone number of each physician and
- 5 health care provider described by Subsection (a) and indicate
- 6 whether the physician or provider is accepting new patients.
- 7 (c) For each health care provider that is a facility
- 8 <u>included in the directory under this section, the directory must:</u>
- 9 (1) list under the facility name separate headings for
- 10 radiologists, anesthesiologists, pathologists, emergency
- 11 department physicians, neonatologists, and assistant surgeons;
- 12 (2) list under each heading described by Subdivision
- 13 (1) each facility-based physician described by Subsection (a)
- 14 practicing in the specialty corresponding with that heading;
- 15 (3) for the facility and each facility-based physician
- 16 <u>described by Subdivision (2)</u>, clearly indicate each health benefit
- 17 plan issued by the issuer that may provide coverage for the services
- 18 provided by that facility or physician; and
- 19 (4) include the facility in a grid listing of all
- 20 facilities included in the directory with separate columns
- 21 indicating:
- (A) the name of the facility;
- 23 (B) the municipality in which the facility is
- 24 located or county in which the facility is located if the facility
- 25 is in the unincorporated area of the county;
- 26 <u>(C) for each specialty of facility-based</u>
- 27 physician practicing at the facility, the name, street address, and

- 1 telephone number of any facility-based physician group described by
- 2 Subsection (a);
- 3 (D) each health benefit plan issued by the issuer
- 4 that may provide coverage for the services provided by the
- 5 facility; and
- 6 (E) each health benefit plan issued by the issuer
- 7 that may provide coverage for the services provided by each
- 8 <u>facility-based physician group.</u>
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 1451.505(c), Insurance Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (c) The directory must be:
- 12 (1) electronically searchable by physician or health
- 13 care provider name, specialty, if any, and location; and
- 14 (2) publicly accessible without necessity of
- 15 providing a password, a user name, or personally identifiable
- 16 information.
- 17 SECTION 4. A health benefit plan issuer shall update the
- 18 issuer's website to conform with Subchapter K, Chapter 1451,
- 19 Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, not later than January 1,
- 20 2020.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
