- 6 SECTION 1. In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on Law
- 8 Enforcement.

- 10 Chapter 1701, Occupations Code.
- 11 SECTION 2. The commission shall study:
- 12 (1) compliance by law enforcement agencies with the
- 13 requirement that a law enforcement agency:
- 14 (A) submit employment termination reports to the
- 15 commission under Section 1701.452, Occupations Code, for a license
- 16 holder who resigns or retires from employment with the law
- 17 enforcement agency, whose appointment with the law enforcement
- 18 agency is terminated, or who separates from the law enforcement
- 19 agency for any other reason; and
- 20 (B) obtain under Section 1701.451, Occupations
- 21 Code, employment termination reports regarding an applicant for
- 22 employment with the agency; and
- 23 (2) the extent to which law enforcement agencies use
- 24 the information in an employment termination report to make

- 1 employment decisions.
- 2 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2020, the commission
- 3 shall report the results of the study and make recommendations to
- 4 the legislature regarding improving the reporting and
- 5 consideration of information concerning license holder
- 6 terminations or separations.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act expires January 1, 2021.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
