- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 38.14(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 7 as follows:
- 8 (b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
- 9 or knowingly and with force takes or attempts to take from a peace
- 10 officer, federal special investigator, employee or official of a
- 11 correctional facility, parole officer, community supervision and
- 12 corrections department officer, or commissioned security officer
- 13 the officer's, investigator's, employee's, or official's firearm,
- 14 nightstick, stun gun, or personal protection chemical dispensing
- 15 device [with the intention of harming the officer, investigator,
- 16 employee, or official or a third person].
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 21 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 22 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 23 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 24 before that date.
