BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 38.14(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 7 as follows:

8 (b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally or knowingly and with force takes or attempts to take from a peace 9 10 officer, federal special investigator, employee or official of a correctional facility, parole officer, community supervision and 11 12 corrections department officer, or commissioned security officer 13 the officer's, investigator's, employee's, or official's firearm, nightstick, stun gun, or personal protection chemical dispensing 14 15 device [with the intention of harming the officer, investigator, employee, or official or a third person]. 16

17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 19 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 20 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 21 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 23 24 before that date.
