## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the status of certain medical residents and fellows as governmental employees for purposes of the Texas Tort Claims Act. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 101, Civil Practice and 5 Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 101.004 to read as 6 follows: 7 Sec. 101.004. STATUS OF MEDICAL RESIDENTS AND FELLOWS. For 8 9 purposes of this chapter, a resident or fellow in a graduate medical training program for physicians that is sponsored by a governmental 10 11 unit, including a medical and dental unit, as defined by Section 12 61.003, Education Code, is considered to be an employee of a governmental unit regardless of the method or source of payment of 13 14 the resident or fellow. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18
