4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 21.04891 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.04891. SPECIAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION. (a) To
8	ensure that there are teachers with special training in providing

- 9 <u>instruction to students with disabilities</u>, the board shall 10 <u>establish a special education certificate</u>.
- 11 (b) To be eligible for a certificate established under this
 12 section, a person must:
- (1) satisfactorily complete the course work for that

 14 certificate in an educator preparation program, including a

 15 knowledge-based and skills-based course of instruction and

 16 field-based experience in providing instruction to students with
- 17 disabilities;
- (2) perform satisfactorily on a special education
 certificate examination prescribed by the board; and
- 20 (3) satisfy any other requirements prescribed by the
- 21 board.
- (c) If the board determines that there is a shortage of teachers who hold special education certificates, the board may
- 24 offer incentives to teachers to become certified under this

1 section.

- 2 SECTION 2. The State Board for Educator Certification shall
- 3 propose rules:
- 4 (1) establishing requirements and prescribing an
- 5 examination for a special education certificate examination as
- 6 required by Section 21.04891, Education Code, as added by this Act;
- 7 and
- 8 (2) establishing standards to govern the approval and
- 9 renewal of approval of educator preparation programs for special
- 10 education certification.
- 11 SECTION 3. Beginning on or after January 1, 2021, a person
- 12 must satisfy the requirements for certification under Section
- 13 21.04891, Education Code, as added by this Act, to receive a
- 14 certification in special education.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
