- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.060(e), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The forms and procedures <u>established and</u> maintained
- 8 under Subsection (d) must:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> comply with Subsection (c); and
- 10 (2) allow the holder of a driver's license or personal
- 11 identification certificate or an authorized agent of the holder to
- 12 add, amend, or delete information described by Subsection (d) by
- 13 <u>submitting an electronic form on the department's Internet website</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2020, the Department of
- 15 Public Safety of the State of Texas shall produce and make available
- 16 on the department's Internet website an electronic form in
- 17 accordance with Section 521.060(e), Transportation Code, as
- 18 amended by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
