1-19 relating to emergency contact and medical information maintained by
 1-20 the Department of Public Safety.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 521.060(e), Transportation Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (e) The forms and procedures established and maintained
 1-25 under Subsection (d) must:

1-26 (1) comply with Subsection (c); and

1-27 (2) allow the holder of a driver's license or personal
 1-28 identification certificate or an authorized agent of the holder to
 1-29 add, amend, or delete information described by Subsection (d) by
 1-30 submitting an electronic form on the department's Internet website.

1-31 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2020, the Department of
 1-32 Public Safety of the State of Texas shall produce and make available
 1-33 on the department's Internet website an electronic form in
 1-34 accordance with Section 521.060(e), Transportation Code, as
 1-35 amended by this Act.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
