3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 441.006(a), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(a) The commission shall:
7	(1) govern the Texas State Library;

- 8 (2) adopt policies and rules to aid and encourage the
- development of and cooperation among all types of libraries, 9
- including public, academic, special, and other types of libraries; 10
- 11 (3) aid those studying problems to be dealt with by
- 12 legislation;
- 13 (4)prepare and make available to the public and
- 14 appropriate state agencies information of public interest
- describing the functions of the commission; 15
- deposit money paid to the commission under this 16
- chapter subject to Subchapter F, Chapter 404; 17
- 18 (6) give to any person contemplating the establishment
- of a public library advice regarding matters such as maintaining a 19
- public library, selecting books, cataloging, and managing a 20
- 21 library;
- 22 (7) conduct library institutes and encourage library
- 23 associations;
- take custody of, preserve, and make available for 24 (8)

- 1 public use state records and other historical resources that
- 2 document the history and culture of Texas as a province, colony,
- 3 republic, or state;
- 4 (9) prepare and make available to the public a
- 5 complete list of every state symbol and place designation,
- 6 including state symbols and place designations made in accordance
- 7 with Chapter 391;
- 8 (10) aid and encourage, by adoption of policies and
- 9 programs, the development of effective records management and
- 10 preservation programs in state agencies and the local governments
- 11 of the state; [and]
- 12 (11) provide library services to persons with
- 13 disabilities in cooperation with the federal government; and
- 14 (12) adopt rules allowing for the storage of original
- 15 <u>documents in digital format in the state archives</u>.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter L, Chapter 441, Government Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Sections 441.1815 and 441.206 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 441.1815. STATE ARCHIVES STRATEGIC PLAN. The
- 19 commission, with input from interested persons, shall develop and
- 20 implement a comprehensive strategic plan regarding the state
- 21 archives. The commission shall update the strategic plan at least
- 22 once every five years. The strategic plan must include:
- 23 (1) an assessment of any current archives backlog;
- (2) a prioritized list of projects and goals related
- 25 to the state archives;
- 26 (3) an evaluation of the resources needed to achieve
- 27 the commission's goals related to the state archives, including the

- 1 impact that different amounts of those resources are expected to
- 2 have on the commission's ability to achieve those goals;
- 3 (4) performance measures, targets, and time frames for
- 4 achieving the commission's goals related to the state archives;
- 5 (5) a mechanism for regular reporting to the
- 6 commission on progress toward achieving the commission's goals
- 7 related to the state archives; and
- 8 <u>(6) opportunities and standards for entering into</u>
- 9 collaborative agreements with interested persons regarding the
- 10 state archives.
- Sec. 441.206. RECORDS OF MEMBER OF LEGISLATURE. (a) A
- 12 member of the legislature may apply to the commission to place
- 13 records of the member's legislative office created or received
- 14 during the member's term of office in a depository other than the
- 15 Texas State Library and Archives.
- 16 (b) The commission shall:
- 17 (1) create a list of preapproved depositories in which
- 18 members of the legislature may place records of their legislative
- 19 offices, including regional historical resource depositories
- 20 described by Section 441.153; and
- 21 (2) by rule adopt policies and procedures to approve
- 22 additional depositories.
- (c) Ownership of records described by Subsection (a) placed
- 24 in a depository other than the Texas State Library and Archives
- 25 remains with the commission. The records may not be intermingled
- 26 with other holdings of the institution that serves as a depository.
- 27 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than September 1, 2020, the Texas

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- 1 State Library and Archives Commission shall:
- 2 (1) adopt rules under Section 441.006(a), Government
- 3 Code, as amended by this Act;
- 4 (2) develop a strategic plan for the state archives
- 5 program as required by Section 441.1815, Government Code, as added
- 6 by this Act; and
- 7 (3) create a list of preapproved depositories and
- 8 adopt rules for approving additional depositories as required by
- 9 Section 441.206, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 (b) Rules adopted under Section 441.206, Government Code,
- 11 as added by this Act, apply only to a member of the legislature
- 12 leaving office after September 1, 2020.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
